



Ahmed Zewail

26 février 1946 – 2 août 2016

Ahmed Zewail avait été élu associé étranger de l'Académie le 21 juin 2005 dans la section de chimie. Prix Nobel de chimie en 1999, Ahmed Zewail était professeur au *California Institute of Technology* (États-Unis). Ses travaux ont permis d'observer en temps réel, c'est-à-dire dans la gamme des femtosecondes, le déroulement le plus intime d'une réaction chimique. Il est devenu possible de comprendre de visu toute la subtilité et la dynamique des molécules au cours des actes chimiques et biologiques les plus élémentaires. Membre de la *National Academy of Sciences* américaine, ainsi que de nombreuses autres Académies, Ahmed Zewail était lauréat entre autre du Prix Wolf en Chimie (1993) et de l'*Albert Einstein World Award* (2006).
