



The IMT – Académie des Sciences Young Scientist Prize

[Established in 2017]

2017 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

In 2017, the French Académie des Sciences will award the IMT – Académie des Sciences Young Scientist Prize of **15,000 euros**.

This annual Prize, established by IMT (Institut Mines-Télécom) in partnership with Fondation Télécom, is intended to reward a scientist who is under 40 years old on January 1st of the year of the prize (this limit may be extended by one year per child), who has contributed to one of the following fields through a major innovation:

- Sciences and technologies of the digital transformation in industry;
- Sciences and technologies of the energy transition;
- · Environmental engineering.

The IMT – Académie des Sciences Young Scientist Prize is awarded without any requirements regarding nationality, to a scientist working in France, or elsewhere in Europe in close collaboration with French teams, and whose research has led to the emergence of innovations and disruptive approaches, and contributed to partner-based research with companies.

Documents for the application file

The files must be submitted to the Académie des Sciences by a laboratory director, institution manager, or a Member of the Académie who supports the application. **Direct applications will not be accepted**. Furthermore, the same individual may not be nominated for two prizes in the same year.

The files must include the following:

- 1. The IMT Académie des Sciences Young Scientist Prize application form
- 2. A letter of support that provides a personal opinion of the applicant (1 page)

 This letter must be sent to the Académie directly and in a confidential manner.
- 3. A brief resume (1 page)
- 4. The candidate's key scientific results (2 pages)
- 5. A list of the main publications (maximum of 10, 1 page)
